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EXPECTED OUTCOMES: SHORT-TERM

<p>More families are equipped with best practice parenting tools and understand the importance of early childhood development</p>	<p>More pre-K providers receive education, technical assistance, and training regarding effective instruction, classroom environments, and child interactions</p>	<p>Increased affordable availability of high quality childcare, especially for those at risk of not meeting developmental and educational milestones</p>	<p>More students K-3 who are at risk of not meeting academic milestones participate in remedial reading and math enrichment activities</p>
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EXPECTED OUTCOMES: MID-TERM

<p>More families are providing a level of care and interaction with their child that supports optimal development and learning</p>	<p>More pre-K providers deliver effective instruction and high quality class room environments/ interactions</p>	<p>More children, especially at-risk children, are receiving high quality care and education</p>	<p>More students K-3 develop grade-appropriate reading and math skills</p>
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ANTICIPATED COMMUNITY CHANGE:

- More children arrive at kindergarten ready to learn
- More 3rd graders will meet or exceed grade level benchmarks for school success
